We would like to thank all parents for the big effort being made to ensure all the children come to school with the appropriate uniform on.

Primary 5 will have their last swimming lesson next Monday 16th October and Primary 6 will start their lessons Monday 6<sup>th</sup> November and finish and finish Monday 18<sup>th</sup> December, swimming lessons cost £14 per pupil.

The Primary 6/7 classes are doing Tin Whistle with Mr Savage and if anyone needs a Tin Whistle there are still some at school here for a cost of £5.

Primary 1 children do not need to take in any sweets as they will have food provided for them. We would ask that no one send in any products containing nuts.

This year's Parent Teacher Meetings will take place Friday 27<sup>th</sup> October for the most part. The meetings will take place throughout the day and the children will not be at school on this date.

Some of the Primary 7 boys and girls took part in the Newry, Mourne and Down Council Cross Country Challenge on Tuesday in Downpatrick. Everyone did really well with the girls finishing eighth overall and the boys finishing fourth overall out of thirty-eight schools. Maith sibh. The boys and girls football teams have a blitz this Friday, 20th in Forkhill at 10.00am.
